Cellphones at School

As you may be aware the Government has introduced regulations that require all state schools to put in place school rules regarding the use of cell phones.

At school we have needed to do very little to implement the government's policy on cell phones, as we already had a no phones policy.

These rules are designed to ensure that the learning of all children is maximised, while minimising any potential for distraction and cyber-bullying. We strongly recommend students do not bring devices to school with them. If a student does bring a cellphone, these must be handed to the teacher to be locked for the day.

It is important to note that if students do make the decision to bring a cellphone on to school grounds, they do so at their own risk. The school is not responsible for any loss or damage caused to any cellphone.

We understand that some parents like their children to have a phone to communicate with them after school, therefore phones will be returned to children prior to after school pick up.

If a parent or caregiver needs to contact their child urgently during the day, they should call the school office.
