Mobile Dental Clinic

Please read the following message from the mobile dental clinic.

Thornton School:

There needs to be a change to the tentative date previously sent to you re Community Dental Service delivery schedule for 2024.

The service will not be coming to Thornton school in 2024.

The priority is to see children needing emergency and urgent care, patients who are under treatment and those who are most overdue.

Our clinical team will contact parents directly to arrange an appointment for your child.

If you have a concern regarding your child's oral health please contact 0800 TALKTEETH (0800 825 583).

You will be asked to email a photo of the concerning tooth to kids.dental@bopdhb.govt.nz include the child's name and date of birth and school they are attending in the email. This will be forwarded to a clinician to be triaged and then they will then make contact with you.

An appointment may be offered at a nearby Mobile Unit or Whakatane Intermediate clinic.
